

Procedures for Bringing, Operating and Transiting Drones with Passengers Arriving in Jordan

The **Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission (CARC)** announces the applicable procedures for drones carried by passengers arriving in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, as an interim measure until the activation of the **Unmanned Aircraft Traffic Management (UTM)** system.

First: Bringing and Operating a Drone in Jordan

This procedure applies to **non-resident passengers** wishing to temporarily bring a drone into Jordan for personal or recreational use.

Passengers wishing to bring and operate a drone in Jordan are required to:

- Contract with a company licensed and approved by CARC to manage and operate unmanned aircraft.
- Provide the licensed company with the required information and documents **sufficiently in advance of their arrival in Jordan**.
- The licensed company shall **submit the application to CARC at least three weeks prior to the passenger's arrival in Jordan** and complete the required procedures and approvals on the passenger's behalf, in accordance with the requirements, documents and information specified in the approved Guide ["دليل ترخيص وتشغيل الطائرات بدون طيار واستخدامها داخل المملكة الأردنية الهاشمية"](#).

The drone may not be operated in Jordan unless the required approvals and the flight authorization issued by CARC have been obtained.

Second: Bringing a Drone without Operating it in Jordan (Transit)

Passengers may bring a drone into Jordan for **transit to a neighboring country**, provided that the drone is not used or operated within Jordanian territory.

The applicable procedures include:

- Declaring the drone upon arrival in Jordan.
- The Jordan Customs Department will seal the drone, and the passenger will sign the required undertaking.
- The integrity of the seal will be verified at the departure border crossing to ensure that the drone leaves Jordan without tampering, damage or loss.
- The passenger is responsible for completing any required procedures and obtaining the necessary approvals in the destination country.
- In case of tampering with the seal, the competent security authority will take the necessary action against the passenger.

Note: The drone may not be used or operated within Jordanian territory during the transit period.

General Note: Contracting with a licensed company or submitting an application does not constitute automatic approval for bringing or operating the drone. Applications are subject to the applicable procedures and approvals of the competent authorities.
