WE, ABDULLAH II BIN AL-HUSSEIN, KING OF THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN,  
PURSUANT TO ARTICLE (31) OF THE CONSTITUTION, AND BASED ON WHAT THE  
CABINET RESOLUTION OF 27 AUG. 2018;

ORDER THE FOLLOWING REGULATION TO BE ENFORCED:

**REGULATION NO. 106 FOR THE YEAR 2018 AND REGULATION NO: (37) FOR  
THE YEAR 2021**

**CIVIL AVIATION CHARGES REGULATION**

Issued pursuant to Article (67) of Civil Aviation Law No. (41)  
for the year 2007 and its amendments

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**Article (1):**

This regulation is called (Civil Aviation Charges Regulation for the year 2018) and shall enter into effect 30 days from the date of its publication at the Official Gazette.

**Article (2):**

The following words and terms wherever appeared in this regulation shall have the meaning shown in front of each unless the context states otherwise:

The Authority      The Civil Aviation Authority.

The Board          The Authority's Board of Commissioners.

Chairman                      Chairman of the Board, Chief Executive of the Authority.

Article (3):

- A. Subject to what is mentioned in paragraph (B) of this Article, fees, charges and costs specified in this regulation are collected against carrying out any actions and services provided by the Authority as indicated in the following:
- 1- The use of Jordanian Civil Airports.
  - 2- Services and Air Navigation Facilities.
  - 3- Licenses, Authorizations, permits, certificates, adoptions, approvals and publications issued by the Authority, pursuant to the Authority Law, or any other applicable legislation, regulations or instructions.
- B. The Authority shall not collect the fees, any charges and costs, mentioned in paragraph (A) above of this Article, if any party is authorized to utilize or operate any aviation facility, where the concluded agreement with that party stipulates that, and in that case the agreement provisions shall be applied after the Cabinet approval on it.

Article (4):

Except for Queen Alia International Airport, Charges against the use of civil airports are set herein as the following:

- 1- Subject to what is mentioned in paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this Clause, landing charges are collected as per maximum take-off weight for the aircraft, according to the certificate of its airworthiness, provided the collected minimum charges in any case not be less than JD 30 where it shall be per each Ton or part thereof as the following:

<b>Description</b>	<b>JD</b>	<b>Fils</b>
First 25 Tons of Aircraft weight	1	535
Following 75 Tons	2	305
Exceeding 100 Tons	2	561

2- A surcharge of (35%) prescribed in item (1) of this Clause, shall be collected against every landing or takeoff during the night. Night is defined as the period between 30 minutes after sunset and 30 minutes before sunrise.

3- A surcharge of (10%) of charges prescribed in item (1) of this Clause, shall be collected against Air Traffic Control Services, provided that such surcharge shall not be less than fifteen Jordanian Dinars.

4- (50%) of the landing charges prescribed in item (1) of this Clause, shall be collected on the following:

- Helicopter Aircraft engaged in commercial flights.
- Aircraft engaged in charter flights carrying tourist groups to the Kingdom.

(30%) of the landing charges prescribed in item (1) of this Clause shall be collected on the following:

- Aircrafts engaged in non-commercial flights.
- Foreign Aircraft used for training or crew test flight for the purpose of acquiring licenses or qualifications or testing of the aircraft and its equipment, subject to the prior written approval of airport director.
- Aircrafts engaged in aerial activities for the service of the state.

#### **B- Parking charges outside-Hangars**

1- Subject to item (2) of this Clause, parking charges shall be collected according to the maximum takeoff weight of the aircraft as indicated in the certificate of its airworthiness. Its certificate of airworthiness

2- The first two hours of parking charges shall be exempted, and this charge will be collected on every following hour, provided that the minimum parking charges shall not be less than JD 15 and as indicated below per each ton or part thereof per hour or part thereof as follows:

First 25 Tons of Aircraft weight	-	155
Following 75 Tons	-	108
Exceeding 100 Tons	-	062

In any case of submitting a request for parking for a period exceeding 72 hours, and approving it, the parking charges shall be collected according to the maximum take-off weight of any aircraft, as indicated in the certificate of airworthiness for a period of 24 hours or part thereof as follows:

<b>Description</b>	<b>JD</b>	<b>Fils</b>
For Aircraft weight 5700 Kg or less	26	500
For Aircraft weight 5701 Kg and more	51	191

- 3- The prescribed charges in items (4) and (5) of Clause (A) of this Article are applicable against Aircraft parking pursuant to item (2) of this Clause.

#### **C- Parking charges inside the Hangars**

- 1- Parking charges inside **Hangars** shall be collected according to the maximum take-off weight of any Aircraft as indicated in the certificate of its air worthiness for each (24) hours period or part thereof for each ton or part thereof as follows:

First 25 Tons of Aircraft weight	2	561
Following 75 Tons	1	535
Exceeding 100 Tons	-	768

- 2- The mentioned rules in items 4 and 5 of Clause (A) of this Article are applied for aircraft parking inside **Hangars**
- 3- The minimum collected parking charges inside the **Hangar** shall not be less than JD 30, in any case according to item (1) of this Clause.

**Air Bridge (Jet Ways) Charges:**

- 4- A charge for the use of air bridge for embarkation and disembarkation of passengers to and from Aircraft shall be collected on every two-hours period or part thereof as follows:

Description	JD	Fils
For Aircraft of 90 tons weight or more	61	429
For Aircraft of less than 90 Tons weight.	40	953

- 5- The Board is authorized to extend the specified period in item (1) of this Clause for (30) minutes without any surcharges.

**D-** 50% of the due charges are collected according to Clauses (A), (B), (C) and (D) of this Article, except what is stipulated in items (4) and (5) of Clause (A) and item (3) of Clause (B) of this Article for aircrafts operating to King Hussein International Airport.

**E-** Fees or any charges for using civil airports by aviation academies, institutions and aviation schools are determined by the instructions issued by the Board according to recommendations of the Chairman.

**F-** Passengers Transit Services Fee:

- 1- Passenger transit services fee of (JD 4) Four Jordanian Dinars against each passenger shall be collected.
- 2- The fee prescribed under the provisions of item (1) of this Clause shall be collected by airlines directly in accordance with instructions issued by the Board.

Article (5):

Charges against the use of Queen Alia International Airport are set herein as Follows

**A- Aircrafts Landing Charges**

- 1- Subject to what is mentioned in paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this Clause, landing charges are collected as per maximum take-off weight for the aircraft, according to the certificate of its airworthiness, provided the collected minimum charges in any case not be less than JD 30 where it shall be per each Ton or part thereof as the following:

Description	JD	Fils
First 25 Tons of Aircraft weight	2	377
Following 75 Tons	3	565
Exceeding 100 Tons	4	041

- 2- A surcharge of (35%) prescribed in item (1) of this Clause, shall be collected against every landing or takeoff during the night. Night is defined as the period between 30 minutes after sunset and 30 minutes before sunrise.
- 3- A surcharge of (10%) of charges prescribed in item (1) of this Clause shall be collected against Air Traffic Control Services, provided that such surcharge shall not be less than fifteen Jordanian Dinars.
- 4- (50%) of the landing charges prescribed in item (1) of this Clause, shall be collected on the following:
- Helicopter Aircraft engaged in commercial flights.
  - Aircraft engaged in charter flights carrying tourist groups to the Kingdom.
- 5- (30%) of landing charges prescribed in item (1) of this Clause shall be collected on the following:
- Aircrafts engaged in non-commercial flights.

- Foreign Aircraft used for training or crew test flight for the purpose of acquiring licenses or qualifications or testing of the aircraft and its equipment, subject to the prior written approval of airport director.
- Aircrafts engaged in aerial activities for the service of the state.

**B- Parking charges outside Hangars**

- 1- Subject to item (2) of this Clause, parking charges shall be collected according to the maximum takeoff weight of the aircraft as indicated in ~~the~~ its certificate of ~~its~~ airworthiness.
- 2- The first two hours of parking charges shall be exempted, and this charge will be collected on every following hour, provided that the minimum parking charges shall not be less than JD 15 and as indicated below per each ton or part thereof per hour or part thereof as follows:

- 3- In any case of submitting a request for parking for a period exceeding 72 hours, and approving it, the parking charges shall be collected according to the maximum take-off weight of any aircraft, as indicated in the certificate of airworthiness for period of 24 hours or part thereof as follows:

For Aircraft weight 5700 Kg or less	39	614
For Aircraft weight 5701 Kg and more	79	227

- 4- The prescribed charges in items (4) and (5) of Clause (A) of this Article are

applicable against Aircraft parking pursuant to item (2) of this Clause.

**C- Parking charges inside the Hangars:**

- 1- Parking charges inside Hangars shall be collected according to the maximum take-off weight of any Aircraft as indicated in the its certificate of airworthiness for each (24) hours period or part thereof for each ton or part thereof as follows:

Description	JD	Fils
First 25 Tons of Aircraft weight	4	041
Following 75 Tons	2	377
Exceeding 100 Tons	1	188

- 2- The mentioned rules in items 4 and 5 of Clause (A) of this Article are applied for aircraft parking inside hangars.
- 3- The minimum collected parking charges inside the **Hangars** shall not be less than JD 30, in any case according to item (1) of this Clause.

**D- Air Bridge (Jet Ways) Charges:**

A charge for the use of Air Bridge for embarkation and disembarkation of passengers to and from Aircraft shall be collected on every two-hours period or part thereof as follows:

Description	JD	Fils
For Aircraft of 90 tons weight or more	95	072
For Aircraft of less than 90 Tons weight.	63	382

**E- Terminal User Charge:**

- 1- A fee for the use of the passenger terminal of (JD 11.691) Eleven Jordanian Dinars and Six Hundred Nighty One Fils, shall be collected for each passenger departing on international flights.
- 2- The fees prescribed under the provisions of item (1) of this Clause shall be collected by airlines directly.



3- Upon collecting the prescribed fee pursuant to this Clause, the regulations related to exemptions as stated in signed agreements between the Government and the airport investor shall be considered.

**F- Passengers Transit Services Fee:**

1- Passenger transit services fee of (JD 5,546) Five Jordanian Dinars and Five Hundred Forty Six Fils against each passenger shall be collected.

2- The fee prescribed under the provisions of item (1) of this Clause shall be collected by airlines directly in accordance with instructions issued by the Board for this purpose.

Article (6):

A- A fuel fee of (1%) of the total claimed amount of money, issued by the supplying company inside the airport, shall be collected.

B- A fee of (JD 2.146) Two Jordanian Dinars and One Hundred Forty Six Fils, for the Common User Terminal Equipment, shall be collected for each passenger departing on an international flight.

C- The airport operator shall directly collect the fee prescribed in this Clause, in accordance with instructions issued by the Board for this purpose.

**D- The provisions of this Regulation as amended and any other amendments thereafter shall apply on tickets issued after its effective date.**

Article (7):

Except for agricultural products, the following allowances are charged at the Air Freight Facilities Center:

A- (JD 0.020) Twenty Fils per Kilogram shall be collected against X-ray inspection of goods.

B- (JD 0.015) Fifteen Fils per Kilogram shall be collected against handling of goods destined for air cargo.

C- (JD 0.005) Five Fils per Kilogram shall be collected against handling of goods not destined for air cargo.

Article (8):

A- Air-Navigation Service Charges of Aircrafts flying over Jordan Airspace shall be collected of an amount of (JD 1) One Jordanian Dinar for each Ton or part thereof according to maximum takeoff weight, as indicated in the certificate of airworthiness.

B- According to Clause (A) of this Article, the collected charges, in any case, shall not be less than (JD 40) Forty Jordanian Dinars.

Article (9):

Air navigation service collected charges according to the provisions of this regulation are as follows:

A- Charges against sale of Aeronautical Information Manual, its amendments and supplements, are according to the following:

- 3- Any official body, the Board decides to exempt.

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Article (17):

A- The entire set up fee or charge against issuing any of the authorization, license permit, certificate, confirmation and approval shall be collected and specified as a temporary license, if the temporary period for the license is equal or more than (50%) of the period specified for the permanent license.

- 1- United Nation Aircrafts, its specialized agencies and aircrafts of international & regional organizations.
- 2- Aircrafts which participate free of charge in rescue and search operations, relief, salvage or other humanitarian services.
- 3- Aircrafts of official delegations.
- 4- The Aircrafts of the officially approved clubs and institutes, subject to reciprocity.
- 5- Government Aircrafts which carry out public services.
- 6- National Aircrafts which perform non-commercial flights for the purpose of technical testing for local navigational aids, or testing the aircraft or its equipment, provided acquiring the approval of the Chairman whom he authorizes in writing at least twenty four hours before takeoff.
- 7- The forced landing of an Aircraft after takeoff, due to technical issues or according to a request from official authorities.
- 8- Authority employees; including vacations and examinations fees, as their job nature stipulates and according to the terms placed by the Board.
- 9- Non-working new pilots, of which the Minister of Transportation decides whom to fully or partially exempt from the fees due to certain considerations recommended by the Chief Commissioner
- 10- The authority work units, its departments and directorates.
- 11- Any other Aircrafts the Minister of Transportation decides to fully or partially exempt, due to certain considerations recommended by the. Chief Commissioner

B- The Aircrafts parking for maintenance purposes are exempted only from hangar

parking charges, provided that the parking period shall not exceed three months.

Article (22):

Upon implementing the Articles of this regulation, the specific items of exemptions, mentioned in the concluded agreements between the Kingdom Government and other parties, are to be placed into consideration for exemption.

Article (23):

The Board shall issue the adequate instructions to implement the Articles of this regulation after they are recommended by the Chief Commissioner

Article (24):

The Civil Aviation Charges Regulation No. (45) of 2007 is hereby **cancelled**.
